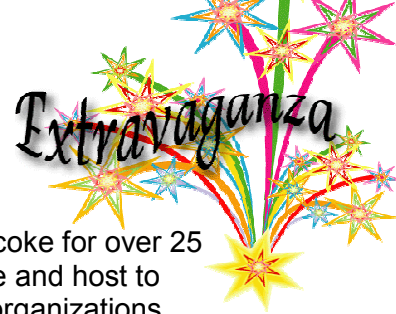

Franklin Horner Community Centre has served the residents of the South Etobicoke for over 25 years. The Centre is a registered non-profit charitable organization, and is home and host to programs and services, along with program and meeting space for community organizations, groups and individual members. We have 1200 individual memberships and 52 diverse groups.
